【講座内容 Course Description】

(1) WORLD TRADE LAW

The course will introduce students to the key legal principles associated with the World Trade Organization (WTO), the chief organization governing the laws which relate to the flow of goods and services across international borders and around the world. It will explore the main agreements of the WTO, examining how they work, explaining their economic purpose and addressing some of the key controversies, notably the conflict between Member State sovereignty and international obligations as embodied by the WTO framework. It will consider some of the leading cases brought through the WTO Dispute Settlement System as well as academic debates concerning the WTO and its future role in global governance in light of the rise of bilateralism and emerging threats of protectionism.

(2) LAW OF INTERNATIONAL SALES

Students will be able to understand the main commercial features and legal framework of the large-scale sale of goods between trading partners in different countries. The topics will include introduction to the common law, harmonization of international commercial law, choice of law and jurisdiction clauses, CISG and other major conventions relating to international sales, the Bill of Lading, Incoterms, remedies for a breach and payment for international transactions.

(3) THE EU AND THE GLOBAL LEGAL ORDER

The course develops an understanding of the main substantive aspects of EU Law including (i) the political institutions of the EU, and the Court of Justice and its jurisdiction, (ii) the EU competences involved in its global activities and (iii) the legal principles and themes underlying the EU's interactions in the global legal order. The course also provides the skills to understand and analyse the sources of EU constitutional law, especially judicial decisions, relevant to the EU's activities in the global legal order, and to examine sources of soft law relevant to the field. The course considers the influence of the EU in the global legal order and conversely examines the influence of the global legal order on the EU, especially in the post-Brexit climate. The course thus enables students to develop a framework for analysing the internationalisation of European law and the Europeanisation of international law.

(4) EUROPEAN IP LAW

The course aims to provide a focus on some of the concepts behind the leading forms of intellectual property law, including trademarks, patents, copyright, designs and geographical indications, within the framework of EU primary and secondary legislation and the European Patent Convention. Pertinent case law from inter alia the European Union Intellectual Property Office (EUIPO) and the European Patent Office will be highlighted and analysed.
